How to get to La Seigneurie du Triton

Leaving from the Quebec City region

1) Travelling by car

- Take highway 40 West
- Take the 220 Champlain, Lac-à-la-Tortue, Grand-Mère exit
- Turn right at the first street light in Saint-Georges, heading for La Tugue
- Turn left at the second street light. At the stop sign turn right on route155 North heading for La Tuque
- Go through the city of La Tuque and follow the 155 North to the 150 kilometre-marker, located at about 45 kilometres north of La Tuque
- Turn right, heading for Lac-Édouard village. Upon arriving at Lac-Édouard village (which is located 10 km from the pier), call us at 653-2509 to notify us of your arrival so that we can organize the boat transfer to La Seigneurie du Triton. Arrival at 6:00 p.m. Departure envisaged at the beginning of afternoon.

2) Travelling by train

You may only travel by train following the fixed schedule either heading for Triton on Mondays, Wednesdays and Fridays or returning towards Rivière-à-Pierre on Tuesdays, Thursdays and Sundays. Departures from Rivière-à-Pierre are at 12:49 pm.

You must reserve your train ticket at least 15 days before your departure date by communicating with Maryse Perron at the following numbers: (418) 323-2106 or (418) 323-2117. Cost for an adult round trip ticket is very affordable and a special rate is available for children.

Directions to get to the Rivière-à-Pierre station which is about one hour from Quebec City:

- Take highway 40 West
- Take the 281-North Pont-Rouge, Saint-Raymond, Neuville exit
- Follow route 365 up to Saint-Raymond de Portneuf
